

Michael J. Fox (Later episodes of Family Ties. Guybrush does not have the savvy of Marty McFly from Back to the Future) Judge Rheinhold (Ruthless People).

LeChuck, the zombie-pirate and demon-pirate:

Another one of the "Barbery Coast" barbers and a retired pirate. He is the more refined of the three, and a skilled marksman, who Guybrush must challenge to a duel. VanHelgen is more of a gentlemanly bloodthirsty pirate. He also plays a mean banjo, in the style of Eddy VanHalen (and sings in the interactive part).

Voice has Dutch accent, more refined speech, but still piratey. Must be able to sing.

Dinghy Dog:

LeChuck's henchman from the Big Whoop carnival. He works at the guess your weight booth when he's not doing LeChuck's dirty work. He's a thug in a big Disneyland style mascot costume of a pirate dog.

Voice is of a nutty cartoon, sort of like a pirate version of Goofy. Zany and Cartoony.

Wally:

A small man who looks and sounds like he's about 8 years old. Formally a geeky cartographer, now manning a cannon since being brainwashed into LeChuck's pirate way of life at the end of Monkey 2.
